## Course Information

### General Introduction

The EURACT Advanced Teaching Skills Course is aimed at teachers of general practice in BME, vocational training or CPD, with some prior knowledge and /or experience of teaching (for example through attending the EURACT Leonardo Course for new teachers). The course will provide high quality resource materials to each participant to help them during the course and to enable them to cascade their new competences through providing follow up courses at home. Teaching methods will be active and participatory and the course will address the needs of those involved in department based teaching as well as individual trainers.

The whole course will be held in English. All teaching materials will be provided in English.

### Contents of the course:

There will be three master-class style modules each consisting of two sessions of three and a half hours. The topics will be:

1. Teaching from the consultation.
2. Managing problem trainees.
3. Small group facilitation and leadership.

### Course structure:

The course will last for three and a half days, virtually all in small group workshops. Small groups maximum of eight participants each (ie 24 total). There will be an introduction and group forming session, then each group would rotate through three one-day modules. At the end of each day there will be a review of group processes and/or a goldfish bowl session with the tutors.

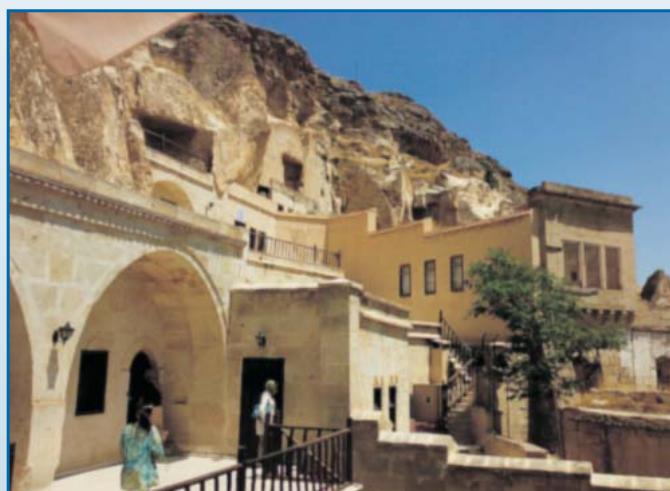
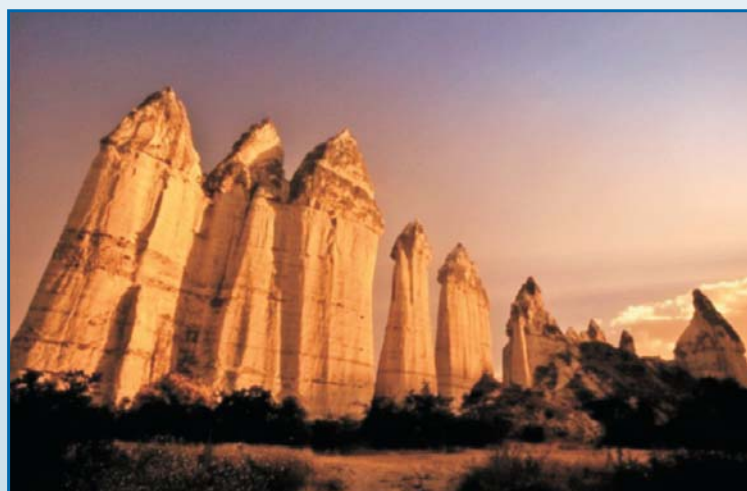
### General information

- The course will be held in Cappadocia, Nevşehir (TURKEY), at the Hotel Dedeman Cappadocia. Participants will stay in the same hotel, in the center of Cappadocia.



### Cappadocia - TURKEY

Some three million years ago, violent volcanic eruptions covered the plateau in this area with tufa, a soft stone comprised of lava, ash and mud. Subsequently, the wind and rain have eroded the brittle rock to form a spectacular surrealistic landscape of rock cones and capped pinnacles, called FAIRY CHIMNEYS, that are painted in colours ranging from warm reds and gold to cool greens and greys. During Byzantine times, Christian chapels and monasteries were hollowed out of the rock, and later these dwellings served as refuge for Christians, persecuted by the Romans.
